


Anna

Ganwyd Anna Barratt ym 1969 yn Abertawe. Enillodd radd BA mewn Celfyddydau Cain ym Mhrifysgol Solent Southampton ym 1996 ac MA mewn Celfyddyd Gain/ Printio yn Ysgol Gelf Wimbledon ym 1999. Enillodd Anna Dystysgrif Ôl-orfodol mewn Addysg yn 2014.

Anna Barratt was born in 1969 in Swansea. She gained her BA Fine Arts in Southampton Solent University 1996 and MA in Fine Art/Print at Wimbledon School of Art 1999. Anna gained A Post Compulsory Certificate in Education in 2014.

She lives and works in Swansea. Anna Barratt's art practice moves from drawing, painting, sculpture, photography and animation. She sees her work as a way to filter the bombardment of infinite images, sounds, senses, emotions and thoughts. Her images exhibit an oscillation between receptiveness and detachment.

Anna Barratt works freelance in art education with schools, galleries, colleges and community participation and is currently one of the Glynn Vivian art gallery arts associate. Anna works with the Young Art force Group, and has recently started the Gallery's Sunday Youth Group sessions with fellow Associate Artist Amy Treharne.
