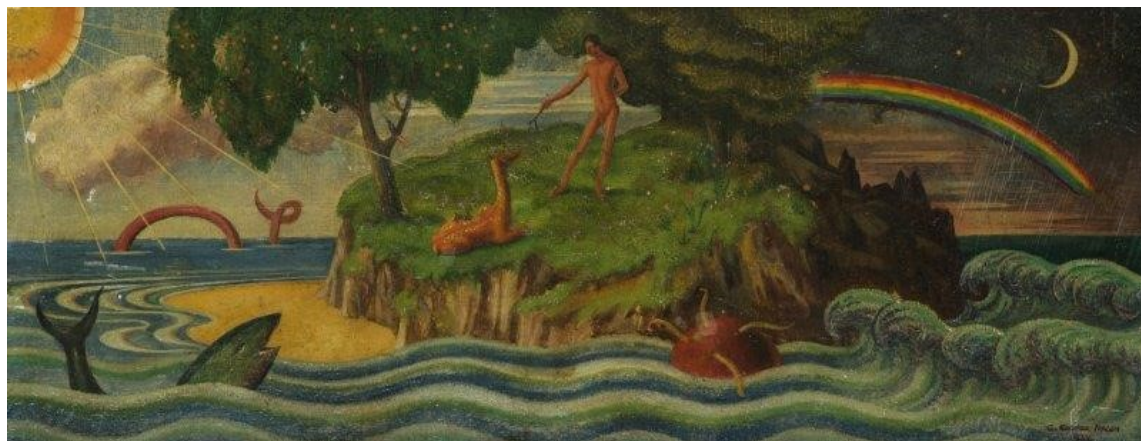


George Cooper Mason and the Fantasy Rainbow
