can you fill in the details?





Imagine Richard Glynn Vivian is having a hard day, what do you think his cook will serve him for dinner to try to cheer him up?








Paintings often help us imagine what things were like before people had cameras.

Can you spot the things which don't belong in this painting?





Some artists use a set of rules or processes to make their work.








Pushing paper is a phrase used to describe doing boring work in an office or at a desk.
