


Rainbow bunting


You will need:

- Rainbow coloured crayons, felt pens or paints
- A large piece of paper
- Scissors
- A length of ribbon or string
- Clothes pegs



Use crayons, paints or felt pens in the colours of the rainbow to cover a large sheet of paper with rainbows. Plain coloured wallpaper works really well for this, and you can use any end of roll pieces you have around the house. You can even use textured paper, or smaller pieces of scrap paper!

When you're finished with colouring, mark out triangular shapes on your paper. Either aim for the most triangles you can fit in to the sheet, or look for the areas with the best patterns and colours.



TIP: you could cut out a viewing stencil to use with your Art Baba and help them look at small areas of their colouring at a time, before selecting their favourite bits to use as bunting pieces!

Cut out your triangles.

TIP: You don't have to stick to triangles, you could use any shapes to make our bunting. How about rainbow hearts?

Use clothes pegs to peg your cut out triangles onto a length of ribbon or string.

(TIP: You could even paint string a bright colour to complement your bunting!).

Now hang up you gorgeous bunting for everyone to see and cheer up passers-by!
