
GLYNN VIVIAN Bird feeders



You will need:

- An orange or empty yogurt pot
- •About 1/3 of a block of lard or suet
- String
- •A handfull of Bird food (dried bread, grains, dried cat food, old cheese (grated), cereal are also fine, but make sure they are free from any artificial sweetners)
- Wooden spoon
- Saucepan or bowl
- A twig

If you're using an orange cut it in half and scoop

out the insides. Make two holes in the top of the orange or yogurt pot, and thread your string through to make a loop. Knot each end. Heat the lard or suet in a pan until just melted (hob or microwave is fine).

BE VERY CAREFUL! THIS SHOULD ONLY BE DONE BY AN ADULT.

The pan and fat will be hot! Stir in your birdseed, then use a spoon to press the mixture into the empty orange halves or yogurt pot. Stick a twig into the mixture for birds to perch on. Leave to cool, then hang it on a suitable tree branch and wait to see what birds come to feed!
